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Each year in the UK more than 20,000 children along with their mothers, flee domestic abuse to seek sanctuary in refuge. Typically leaving home with only the clothes on their backs, these children will have witnessed or experienced emotional, violent, and even sexual abuse, and arrive in refuges, traumatised, and with no possessions.

In collaboration with Women's Aid partner charities and corporate supporters, KidsOut provides these children with new toys, fun days out, and so much more, so that they feel valued and not forgotten.

In addition, the charity takes thousands of disadvantaged children on fun days out, including those with life-limiting health conditions, children who are carers for parents and or siblings, and children from families who are experiencing

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

#### KidsOut Toy Boxes

Moving into a refuge can be particularly traumatic for children, especially when they have already left their school, friends and possessions behind. With their mother's attention and resources typically focused on acquiring basic necessities, purchasing toys and going on Fun Days out are often way down the list. To make the children feel welcome and bring a smile to their faces, KidsOut provides each child with a gender and age appropriate box of new toys and books on arrival in refuge. Each toy box typically consists of a family game, jigsaw puzzle, craft activity set, action figure/doll, books and a cuddly toy. For some children, owning a brand new toy is something they have never experienced.

#### The Shop at Christmas

KidsOut's Giving Tree initiative invites companies and individuals to 'Ditch Secret Santa' and buy toys for children in local refuge homes instead. Many of the recipients are children who have escaped domestic violence and have been forced to flee their homes quickly and leave all their possessions behind them. Without the Giving Tree, these vulnerable children may not otherwise receive anything to open on Christmas Day. How it works: Buy a gift for a child from the Giving Tree – Fun & Happiness Shop on our website and your gift will be delivered to a vulnerable child by our KidsOut team in time for the big day.

#### The shop throughout the year

Throughout the rest of the year the KidsOut Fun & Happiness ShopM provides the opportunity to buy a happy memory for a vulnerableM child, by way of a Fun Day out, or a toy or book for a child arriving inM refuge. The children visit the seaside, theme parks, adventureM playgrounds, zoos, and more. Many of these children will never haveM experienced such activities, some will have never seen the sea, and the trips provide children with happy memories to cherish.







#### KidsOut Multi-Sensory Environments

KidsOut provides multi-sensory environments to help young children learn and explore creatively. The sensory environments particularly benefit children with learning and physical disabilities.. Each multi-sensory unit is semi-portable and can be used to adapt a room or space into a dedicated specialist care area. The units include coloured lighting, bubble tubes, effects projectors, sound and video projection. By controlling these elements, children are able to engage multiple senses helping with the child's development whilst having fun learning.
